Accepted forms of artwork: drawing, painting, printmaking, computer-generated image, photograph or photographic collage. Art must be original – reproductions of other artwork are not accepted. No

trademarked content may be used in your design. Entries must be sent either by email, or online, by a legal guardian, along with the required release form, please see official rules and guidelines for more information.

- One (1) winner will be selected by a diverse panel of judges, including Astronauts (ret.), art educators and professionals.
